Ad Valorem Tax Election



THE FACTS

Our school system ranks 132 out of 137 school systems in the state in terms of local funding support. Alabama currently ranks 50th out of 50 states in the U.S. in terms of property tax revenue per-capita. Butler County has a current Ad Valorem school tax rate of 12 mills compared to the state average of 18.2 mills.

If our taxpayers approve the tax proposal, our local school tax millage will go from 12 mills to 18 mills. This will cost the taxpayer with an average home in our community (\$75,000 market value) an estimated \$3.75 per month increase...less than a dollar a week. The proposed 6 mill increase will generate approximately \$1.4 million annually in additional revenue. The categories in which the additional revenue would be spent include, but are not limited to: Curriculum Resources, Extra-Curricular Activities for both elementary and secondary students and Current Debt.
