Butler County School System Student Feeding Program Information

Butler County School System's Child Nutrition Program will continue to provide nutritional breakfasts and lunches for students during its remote (at home) learning period from January 6, 2021 through January 15, 2021. Meals will be delivered to students who are transported by school bus at their regular pick up locations beginning January 6, 2021. Meals will be delivered in the afternoons on week days after 2:00 p.m.

Students who are not transported by a school bus may pick up meals at the school cafeterias (outside entrances) from 10:30 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. on January 6 – 8 and January 11 - 15.

Parents and guardians are urged to maintain contact with their child's teachers and frequently monitor their work assignments for completion during the remote learning period. Our principals and teachers are on duty and ready to assist as needed. We appreciate the patience and understanding of our school community as we strive to provide the best possible educational services for our students during this challenging school year.
